- NUTEX: AWAITING FURTHER REVIEW FROM CITY ATTORNEY. WE ARE GETTING A LOT OF INTEREST BETWEEN BURGER KING AND MCDONALDS SINCE NUTEX IS EXPANDING MERCANTILE RD. ACROSS ERBY CAMPBELL BLVD.

THEY ARE REQUESTING AN INCENTIVE PACKAGE THAT INCLUDES OPENING A ROYSE CITY LOCATION AT THE OLD FIRE STATION LOCATED AT 262 E. MAIN ST. THE INCENTIVE PACKAGE WOULD COVER THE FULL COST OF INSTALLING A SPRINKLER SYSTEM, A REIMBURSEMENT GRANT OF \$100K, A LOAN (NOT TO EXCEED \$250K), AND THE NEGOTIATED SALE OF THE BUILDING AT THE END OF A 5-YEAR LEASE.
